Now that you've each observed a ritual and documented its essential features, as a group you will now create a new collective ritual.

## **Step One:**

- Make a list of all of the features of the rituals you individually observed (these should come from the details you underlined in your fieldnotes)
- Identify which elements are shared across the different rituals.

# Step Two: Create your own ritual!

Write up a "how-to" manual of your ritual that should include the following sections:

# <u>Description of the following elements (and more):</u>

- key symbols
- o symbolic accomplishments
- o authorized figures,
- repetitive practice
- o practices/ behaviors/ language set off from normal life)

### Identification of

- o what the ritual is for
- o what kind of ritual it is,
- o who is its audience and who are its participants
- o where and when it's performed

## Questions you should be able to answer include:

- What actions make this event different from other events that the participants participate in everyday
- o How often is it repeated?
- o What does the ritual say about the culture or society performing it?
- o What do these rituals accomplish?
- o What symbols are used; how and why?
- o What myths are expressed and what do they mean?
- o How are ritual elements used, and what for?

This description should be between 1.5-2 single spaced pages. *Be creative and include as much detail as possible!*
